Who We Helped Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Ohio

The Champion Cares Foundation supported Big Brothers Big Sisters for their largest fundraising event of the year, Taste of Class for Kids, which helps fund their important mentorship and youth development programs.

Cristo Rey Columbus High School

We sponsored 4 new students for Cristo Rey's Professional Work Study Program for the 2019-2020 school year.

Ronald McDonald House

The Champion Cares Foundation supported the Ronald McDonald house through their Handbag Hullabaloo fundraiser, to raise funds for their important work in keeping children and families close together during hospitalization and medical treatment.

YWCA Family Center

The annual Champion Cares Golf Invitational proudly raised money for the YWCA Family Center, to help them house homeless families and children in Central Ohio, providing meals, a safe place to sleep, personal necessities, and programs to help parents get back on their feet.

The Ohio State University Foundation

The Champion Cares Foundation supported Pelotonia, the premier fundraising event in Central Ohio for the Ohio State University Comprehensive Cancer Center. Pelotonia attracts thousands of participants each year to fundraise while participating in a bike ride that travels all over Central Ohio, with some participants riding up to 200 miles.



The Champion Cares Foundation partners with The Columbus Foundation to distribute grants. Below is more about The Columbus Foundation and how they help.

In 2019, The Columbus Foundation awarded \$182.5 million in grants to support nonprofits improving central Ohio, and beyond.

Since their founding, an extraordinary \$2.68 billion in grants has benefited a wide range of causes, from social services and the arts, to conservation, healthcare, education, and more.

The generous gifts and bequests received from donors in 2019 totaled \$238.2 million, the fourth highest annual amount in the Foundation's history. These gifts created new funds and added to existing funds and foundations held at The Columbus Foundation.

As of December 31, 2019, the assets of the Foundation stood at \$2.68 billion, held in 2,888 charitable funds and 28 Supporting Foundations.
