



Champion Cares Foundation surpasses \$2.5+ Million given

Boys & Girls Clubs

We granted \$250,000 to Boys & Girls Clubs of Central Ohio as part of our \$2.5 million lead gift for the construction of the all new Champion Companies Milo Grogan Clubhouse.

Children's Hunger Alliance

The Champion Cares Foundation was proud to sponsor Moler Elementary School in Columbus Ohio for the pilot program of CHA's Adopt-A-School Program. The sponsorship provides weekend and school break meals for every week of the 2022-2023 school year to students who experience food insecurity.

A Kid Again

We partnered with Feazel Roofing for their annual fundraiser to support A Kid Again, which is a Central Ohio organization that exists to foster hope, happiness, and healing for children with life-threatening conditions and their families. It provides children who are in and out of hospitals opportunities to have fun and be a kid again!

YWCA Family Center

We committed part one of a two year commitment to the YWCA Family Center in Columbus Ohio to fund improvements and renovations to their outdoor spaces for the families and children who are staying at the Center to enjoy.



Columbus Early Learning Centers

We were proud to provide 1 of eventually 3 grants to Columbus Early Learning Centers for a new facility in Central Ohio for early childhood education and childcare.

Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Ohio

We sponsored the Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Ohio Taste of Class for Kids event, which is a large fundraiser BBBS holds each year to help facilitate their youth mentorship programs, including one-on-one youth mentoring, college and career readiness, and sending youth to their Camp Oty'Okwa year-round camp program.

Sponsored Cristo Rey High School's Garden Party Fundraiser that celebrates and supports the students of Cristo Rey Columbus High School and its mission of providing a high-quality, affordable education to young men and women and preparing them to excel in college, in career, and in character. 


