
This past year also brought us closer with new organizations, such as Pelotonia, to formalize partnerships that Champion Cares can include in its future giving efforts. Pelotonia's focus is to accelerate funding for innovative cancer research through a series of fundraising events each year, including its annual Ride Weekend. Pelotonia directs 100 percent of every dollar raised by participants to cancer research at The Ohio State University Comprehensive Cancer Center. Partnering with Pelotonia allows Champion Cares to connect with those in need that fall under our Health & Wellness pillar, where we look to partner with organizations that focus on health, which could be rehabilitative health, disease and disorder treatment, medical research or mental health and crisis intervention.

Throughout 2023 we also enjoyed being present within the Central Ohio community as we partnered with Children's Hunger Alliance to distribute meal boxes to our Adopt a School partner Moler Elementary, began construction on another home for a deserving family with Habitat for Humanity and chaperoned summer field trips for the children of the YWCA Family Center.

Who We Are





Team Champion Rides 591 Miles Throughout Central Ohio

How Pelotonia Helps

Pelotonia is an annual bicycling tour and nonprofit organization based in Columbus, Ohio, that raises money for cancer research at The Ohio State University Comprehensive Cancer Center – Arthur G. James Cancer Hospital and Richard J. Solove Research Institute.

Team members can participate as a rider, virtual rider or volunteer. Those who choose to ride their bikes make a commitment not only to train, but to raise a specific amount of money. The fundraising amount is based on the distance for each Pelotonia route. The routes range from 25 to 200 miles.

100% of the funds donated to Pelotonia go directly toward funding cancer research.



Team Champion raises \$62,475 in 2023!

Twelve riders represented the Champion peloton in 2023, along with 17 volunteers who together raised \$62,475. Since 2018, the Champion peloton has raised over \$175,500 for cancer research.









VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT

Summer Field Trips with YWCA Family Center

The Champion Cares Foundation sponsored the Safe & Sound summer youth field trip program through the YWCA Family Center in 2023. This is a cause Champion Cares has supported in the past, but had been paused during the COVID pandemic. We jumped at the opportunity to sponsor this program when we heard of its return. The Safe & Sound Child Care program provides support for young children, including unique and new learning experiences. During the months of June through August, Champion Cares funded six field trips and provided 26 volunteers to help chaperone day trips to exciting places across Central Ohio. Champion Cares has already committed to sponsoring the summer field trips in 2024 and looks forward to providing fun experiences to the children of the YWCA Safe & Sound program.

Children's Hunger Alliance

The Champion Cares Foundation was proud to sponsor Moler Elementary School in Columbus Ohio for the pilot program of CHA's Adopt-A-School Program. The sponsorship provided weekend and school break meals for every week of the 2022-2023 school year to students who experience food insecurity.

A Kid Again

We partnered with Feazel Roofing for their annual fundraiser to support A Kid Again, which is a Central Ohio organization that exists to foster hope, happiness, and healing for children with life-threatening conditions and their families. It provides children who are in and out of hospitals opportunities to have fun and be a kid again.

YWCA Family Center

The Champion Cares Foundation continued its support with a 2023 contribution to the YWCA Family Center, to help them house homeless families and children in Central Ohio, providing meals, a safe place to sleep, personal necessities and programs to help parents get back on their feet. In addition to these services, The Champion Cares Foundation provided funding and volunteers for the Safe and Sound summer youth field trip program.

Habitat For Humanity

The Champion Cares Foundation was proud to sponsor another house build with Habitat for Humanity - MidOhio in 2023. This build began at the end of 2023 and we're excited for the project to be completed in Spring 2024 for a deserving family to move into.

Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Ohio

We sponsored the Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Ohio Taste of Class for Kids event, which is a large fundraiser BBBS holds each year to help facilitate their youth mentorship programs, including one-on-one youth mentoring, college and career readiness, and sending youth to their Camp Oty'Okwa year-round camp program.

YWCA Family Center is dedicated to eliminating racism, empowering women and promoting peace, justice, freedom and dignity for all. The YWCA Family Center provides emergency shelter and critical services to stabilize homeless families in Central Ohio. A national model, more than 70% of the families who use the YWCA Family Center are able to find housing within 21 days of entering the program.

Children's Hunger Alliance is known for feeding hungry minds and bodies. CHA works to ensure all children are fed regular and nutritious meals and develop lifelong healthy eating habits.
